FOREWORD

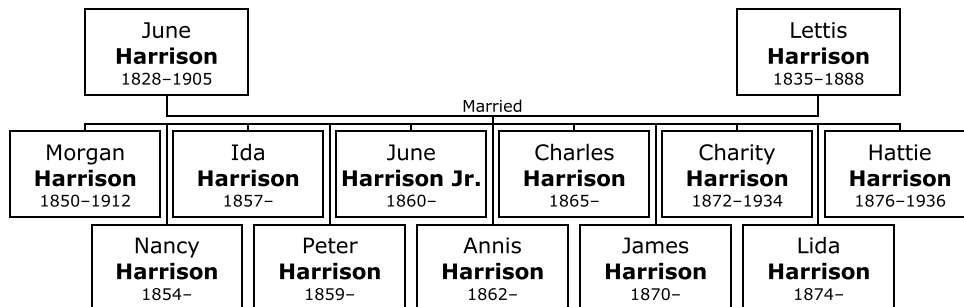
Lettis Harrison

All of Lettis' children attended school after the Civil War. Her complexion was light, and she had long black hair.

June was born in Warren on Tuesday, July 01, 1828. He reached 76 years of age and died in Smoaks on June 01, 1905.

He was a farmer, attended school, and learned to read and write although many of his generation could not.
